TO SEE

An eyewitness is someone who has been there. They have seen with their own eyes. They have heard with their own ears. They have felt what the atmosphere is conveying in the midst of the people. Going to the gay pride parade is never a highlight of my summer but it is always an eye opening experience to the depravity of humankind. This year was no exception. It would be the first time that I saw a 7 year old drag queen headline the event. The reality of seeing that made me furious as I watched adult people grooming him and cheering him on during not only his performance but his march down the streets of Omaha as this little boy was celebrated as a girl in a gown.

I've asked Courtney Farmer to write this newsletter to share about her experience during that July weekend in downtown Omaha. It took her a while to process what her eyes had seen and what she had heard during certain conversations. Please read to the end- we have some wonderful things to tell you about ministry and how you can get involved with Fervent Heart Ministries.

To "see" is to perceive with the eyes and discern visually. On Friday July 12th my eyes would see evilness displayed before children. Angie and I attended the Heartland Youth Pride Rally at the CHI center here in Omaha, NE. This was our first time attending an LGBTQ event that was aimed towards children. As we walked in, we would see over 100 tables being setting up by different businesses, people laughing and deciding how to setup their tables to draw children to them. We began to walk down each isle and saw Planned Parenthood display with an open container of free condoms, tarot card reader, false doctrine of the Bible denouncing the church, merchants selling candles, t-shirts, jewelries, and etc. One table stood out from them all. The table was located on the back wall and the sign on the table read "proceeds go to my operation". As I read this my heart hurt for that person. As other tables displayed rainbows and stickers, this table showed the reality of brokenness, confusion and hurt of homosexuality. It showed the reality that children have and are cutting themselves up to recreate an idol of themselves.

Soon I would see parents happily walk through the door with babies, toddlers, young teens, and teenagers. As the children came in they would look around with curiosity and the people at the tables would begin enticing them to their tables with candy, stickers and toys all covered in pride colors. Children were able to freely roam around at this event. Police were at the door on the main level. I saw parents literally give their children over to these tables and walk away so they could indulge in their own sexual sin with other parents. As children began going up to the 2nd floor and Angie and I followed. Some parents were on the 2nd floor but mostly were on the main floor. No police were on the 2nd floor.



As we came up to the 2nd floor we saw free pizza and pop for the children. There were games in one of the smaller ballrooms along with literature. In the main ballroom there was a dance floor with disco lights and music. Angie and I sat off to the side and watched this horrific display of children running around wrapped in pride flags, boys dressed as women, and parents literally taking pictures of it all. I was spiritually undone seeing the filth, the parents and the innocence of children being groomed. Yet, God reminded me you have to SEE the sin for what it is. What I saw next would mark my heart.

While in the ballroom a man would come onto the stage and welcome the children. He was the MC for the show. He greeted the children in a sexual way with drag words that he would later in the show define what those words meant. As he greeted the children he would then introduce the first act. Drag queen show. A 6 or 7 year old boy in drag would come out onto the stage and begin performing for the children and parents. I was undone as I recorded this boy being prostituted on a stage as people cheered for him. I looked around in disbelief in how this was happening right now. Soon the next act of drag would perform, then the next, then the next. However, these acts would be done by grown men. These men would take off layers of their clothing, sexually dance in front of the children and the music was completely sexually explicit. Soon parents gave money for their child to give the drag queens performing. Nothing was off the table at this moment, the children were literally being sacrificed in this moment to sexual sin. At that point we decided to leave. As we got to the van I began to weep and was in shock to what my eyes saw and my ears heard. Then the next day Angie and I were at the parade standing at the corner of the CHI Center. We saw that same little boy who was dressed in drag the night before dancing in the parade that morning.

The lies that are spoken by the LGBTQ community have no foundation to stand on. So, they turn to children to groom them and sex traffic them all while their parents watch and cheer. I had to see with my own eyes in order to become aware of the strategy of attacks that are being used and to discern what the counter attack should be. I am forever marked by this event.

The next time I was in the CHI Center was Thursday Aug. 29th for the Nebraska Family Alliance Gala fighting against abortion and protecting children and women. How ironic, I thought to myself while leaving the gala that night. It reminded me that people are fighting for our children, and this is part of it. We are in stride to do something historic in voting against abortion so it will not be part of our Constitution. We can't forget what the enemy is trying to do here, we must vote and get others to vote as well. We must go into places and begin speaking to children. You can volunteer at schools to read to kids, become a mentor, host neighborhood gatherings at your house, talk with your Youth Pastor. These are just some examples to begin connecting better with the youth to stand in the gap of their parents. This newsletter was hard to write and probably hard to read as well. However, we have to see the sin for what it is, to speak to it directly and cut off its head. We have to know the giants we face in this.

I pray over your hearts in this battle. Continue to ask what is my part in this?
